BINGO for Luke 6:39-8:15

Give each player a copy of the pictures below and a copy of the following page of blank squares. Players should cut apart their pictures then glue them randomly onto the page with the blank squares. (Thus, each player will have a unique pattern on their board.) Also give the players tokens to place on the squares, such as pieces of paper, pennies, or small candies or pieces of cereal or raisins. (I recommend edible tokens.)

Read through Luke 6:39 - 8:15. When the players hear something that they see on their page, they put a token on it. If you use edible tokens, you can have players who get a bingo eat that line (the "bingo") and then keep playing. In this way, you can keep reading all the way to the end of the passage.
