
The Hereford Mappa Mundi (c. 1285)



Fra Mauro map, 1450 Fra Mauro was a monk who lived in Venice.




The Juan de la Cosa map (painted on a sheep skin), 1500




The Piri Reis map, 1513













Cantino Planisphere, 1502 Drawn by Alberto Cantino, it is the earliest map showing Portuguese territory in Brazil



Japanese portolan map, 1600s






















World map by Mercator, 1587
